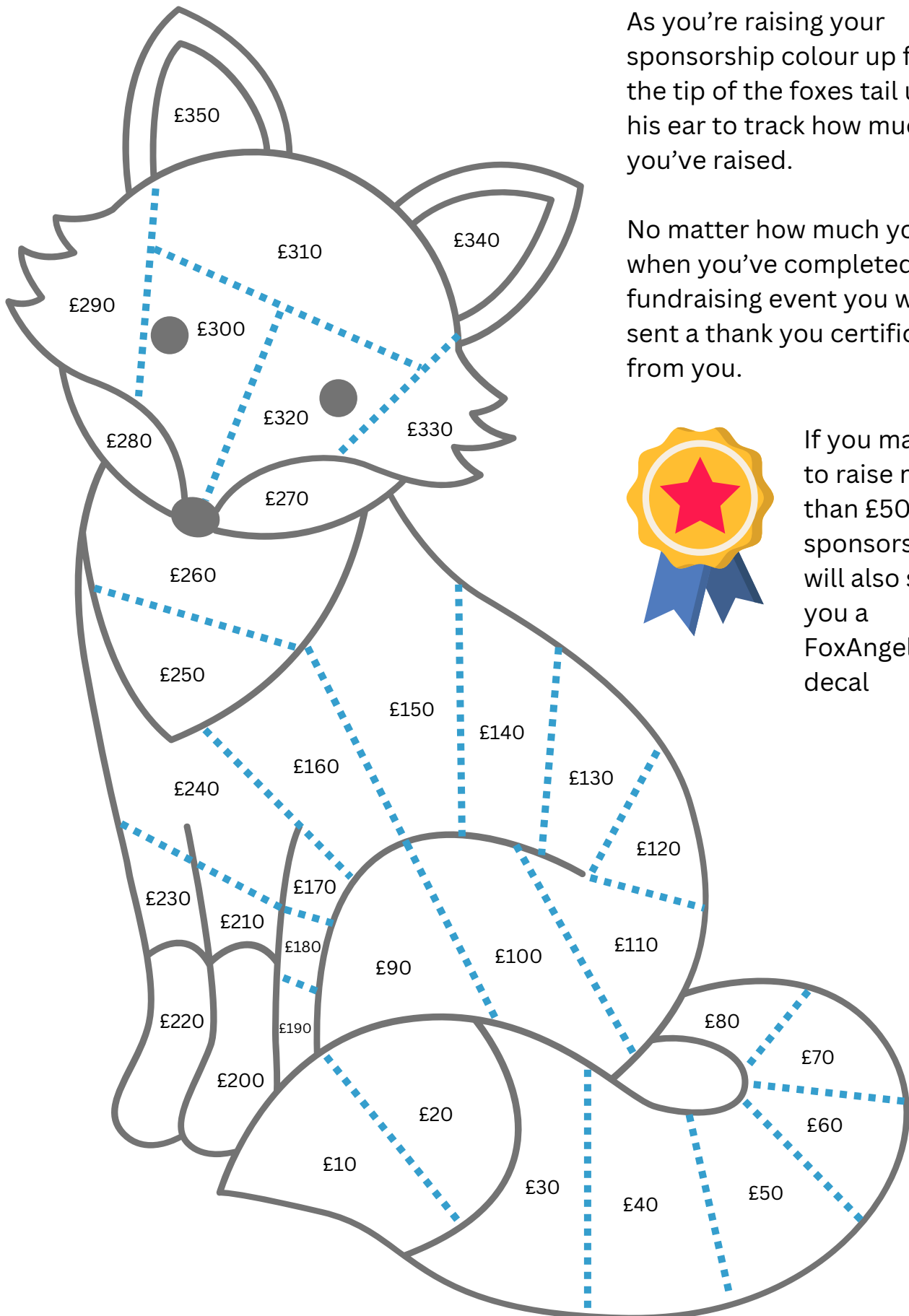
Sponsorship Totaliser
